

The Halcyon 3D Radiotherapy System

With unparalleled precision and speed, Halcyon can target even the most complex lesions, delivering powerful radiation faster with minimal damage to surrounding tissue, in less time, with fewer sessions (sometimes only one) and thus less anesthesia in most cases.

Precision



- Halcyon's innovative collimator is interdigitated and dual layered, allowing for intricate 3D beam shaping with a 5 mm resolution and an unprecedented 0.01% leakage of radiation to non-target tissues.
- Treatment is 100% image guided with a 3D CT that has a large field of view and excellent soft tissue definition, enabling precise intensity-modulated radiation therapy (IMRT).

Speed

- Halcyon features a gantry rotation speed that is four times faster than other radiation systems.
- Faster speeds enable more complex targets to be treated in the same time as typical treatments, reducing the impact of anesthesia.
- Ultrafast imaging reduces the effect of motion created by breathing.
